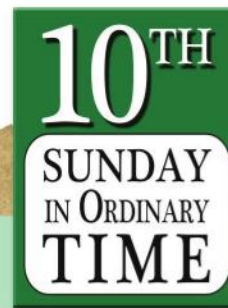

10th Sunday in Ordinary Time Blameless Not Blamers

If you spend any amount of time around young children, you will quickly realize that they like to pass the blame. If you're lucky, they may even accompany it with an irritating whine. What are they trying to accomplish with this behavior? They are trying to get out of trouble, to avoid punishment, often even twisting the truth to do so. Where do they learn this behavior?

The short answer is from our first parents, the founders of Original Sin. In today's first reading, we see Adam passing the blame to Eve, who then passes the blame to the serpent. While neither of them were untruthful, they were definitely trying to avoid punishment. They knew instantly that they had done wrong and disobeyed God. We all know what happens next. They are evicted from the Garden of Eden and begin to experience pain, hunger, illness and ultimately death.

Although we might be tempted to let this first reading get us down, the second reading reminds us of God's promise of redemption: "the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also... Therefore, we are not discouraged... For we know that if our earthly dwelling, a tent, should be destroyed, we have a building from God, a dwelling not made with hands, eternal in heaven."

That is why we can exclaim with joy, "Oh happy fault, Oh necessary sin of Adam, which gained for us so great a Redeemer!" Because of Adam's sin, Jesus came down from heaven to save us. But not only did he save us, he made us members of his own family: "For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

Knowing we are members of God's family should motivate us to end the cycle of blaming and finger pointing that Adam and Eve started and that we and our children continue. It should encourage us to humbly accept our faults, confess our sins and seek to be blameless in God's sight. It should drive us to instead lift others up by sharing the good news of God's unconditional love. Let's take one small step toward making that happen today.

Décimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario Ser sin culpa, no echar la culpa

Si has pasado algún tiempo con niños pequeños, rápidamente te darás cuenta de que a ellos les gusta echarles la culpa a los demás. Y con suerte, es posible que incluso lo acompañen con un lloriqueo irritante. ¿Qué están tratando de lograr con este comportamiento? Están tratando de salir de problemas, de evitar el castigo, y a menudo incluso tuercen la verdad para lograrlo. ¿Dónde aprenden este comportamiento?

La respuesta corta es de nuestros primeros padres, los fundadores del Pecado Original. En la primera lectura de hoy, vemos a Adán culpando a Eva, quien luego le echa la culpa a la serpiente. Si bien ninguno de los dos mintió, definitivamente intentaban evitar el castigo. Supieron instantáneamente que habían hecho mal y desobedecido a Dios. Todos sabemos lo que pasa a continuación. Son desalojados del Jardín del Edén y comienzan a experimentar dolor, hambre, enfermedades y, en última instancia, la muerte.

Aunque podríamos sentirnos tentados a dejar que esta primera lectura nos desanime, la segunda lectura nos recuerda de la promesa de Dios de redimirnos: "aquel que resucitó a Jesús nos resucitará también a nosotros... Por esta razón no nos acobardamos... sabemos que, aunque se desmorone esta morada terrenal, que nos sirve de habitación, Dios nos tiene preparada en el cielo una morada eterna, no construida por manos humanas."

Por eso podemos exclamar con alegría: "¡Oh feliz culpa, oh pecado necesario de Adán, que nos ganó tan grande Redentor!" Debido al pecado de Adán, Jesús descendió del cielo para salvarnos. Pero no sólo nos salvó, sino que nos hizo miembros de su propia familia: "Porque el que hace la voluntad de Dios ése es mi hermano, mi hermana y mi madre".

Saber que somos miembros de la familia de Dios debería motivarnos a poner fin al ciclo de echar la culpa y señalar con el dedo que comenzaron Adán y Eva y que nosotros y nuestros hijos continuamos. Debería animarnos a aceptar humildemente nuestras faltas, confesar nuestros pecados y tratar de ser sin culpa ante los ojos de Dios. Debería impulsarnos a animar a los demás compartiendo la buena nueva del amor incondicional de Dios. Demos un pequeño paso para que eso suceda hoy.
