NEW SERIES: COFFEE TALK WITH FR. DELFIN

Beginning Saturday, July 20th, at 10 am Fr. Delfin will host a quarterly, informal Q&A chat around understanding our Catholic Faith. Ever wondered what's going on during the Mass, what's happening in the Eucharist, the graces of Divine Mercy, the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, what the Church teaches about prophecy and private revelation, the meaning of images, saints, angels, hell, martyrdom, and even exorcism? No topic is off-limits. You bring the questions, and Fr. will provide the coffee and answers.

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Blessings and Glory

The second reading from Ephesians is rather long and with only six sentences, it is not easy to follow. If you take it apart, you see that Paul is very encouraging. He is giving a description of the many blessings God has given us.

He says that we are chosen by God and destined for spiritual blessings: First is Redemption, meaning that Christ saved us from punishment for our sins by forgiving them instead. Second is the plan of God for saving everyone, by making Christ ruler of the universe. We have to accept these gifts by letting go of the temptations around us and holding on to the love we have received from God. The things of the world, possessions, wealth, or power that pretend to make us happy are replaced with love of God; we then share that love with others, so that they know God loves them, too. As our experience of God's love grows, we begin to understand the mystery of how God lives in all people. Another blessing Paul notes is adoption by God to a new relationship as brothers and sisters of Christ; holiness is now for all believers, not just priests or religious.

Paul also reminds us that we are chosen and destined to help God bring his plan, his Kingdom, to completion. When we teach children how to love and share, when we are honest with customers or suppliers, when we are not ashamed to show our faith in Jesus, when we are respectful of the poor, elderly, or disabled, we are slowly building the Kingdom of God, or as Paul says, "to bring all things together in heaven and on earth under Christ" (Eph 1:10)

Paul mentions three times in this reading about "the praise of God's glory." (Eph 1:14) When we are able to help or forgive, or just be a good example to others, we want them to know that God is in all the good we do. Instead of taking credit for the results, we give God the glory. No, you don't have to take off your glasses and put on a red cape before helping others. Just mention that God does the real work, we just try not to get in his way.

Decimoquinto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario Bendiciones y Gloria

La segunda lectura de Efesios es bastante larga y con sólo seis frases no es fácil de seguir. Si lo analizas, verás que Pablo es muy alentador. Está dando una descripción de las muchas bendiciones que Dios nos ha dado.

Dice que somos elegidos por Dios y destinados a recibir bendiciones espirituales: primero está la Redención, lo que significa que Cristo nos salvó del castigo por nuestros pecados al perdonarlos. En segundo lugar está el plan de Dios para salvar a todos, al hacer a Cristo rey del universo. Tenemos que aceptar estos regalos dejando de lado las tentaciones que nos rodean y aferrándonos al amor que hemos recibido de Dios. Las cosas del mundo, posesiones, riquezas o poder que pretenden hacernos felices son reemplazadas por el amor de Dios; luego compartimos ese amor con los demás, para que ellos sepan también que Dios los ama. A medida que crece nuestra experiencia del amor de Dios, comenzamos a comprender el misterio de cómo Dios vive en todas las personas. Otra bendición que Pablo señala es la adopción por parte de Dios a una nueva relación como hermanos y hermanas de Cristo; ahora la santidad es para todos los creyentes, no sólo para los sacerdotes o religiosos.

Pablo también nos recuerda que somos elegidos y destinados a ayudar a Dios a completar su plan, su Reino. Cuando enseñamos a los niños a amar y compartir, cuando somos honestos con los clientes o proveedores, cuando no nos avergonzamos de mostrar nuestra fe en Jesús, cuando somos respetuosos con los pobres, los ancianos o los discapacitados, poco a poco estamos construyendo el Reino de Dios, o como dice Pablo, "hacer que todas las cosas, las del cielo y las de la tierra, tuvieran a Cristo por cabeza" (Efesios 1,10)

Pablo menciona tres veces en esta lectura "para alabanza de su gloria" (Efesios 1,14). Cuando somos capaces de ayudar o perdonar, o simplemente ser un buen ejemplo para los demás, queremos que sepan que Dios está en todo el bien que hacemos. En lugar de atribuirnos el mérito de los resultados, le damos la gloria a Dios. No, no es necesario que te quites los lentes y te pongas una capa roja antes de ayudar a los demás. Solo mención que Dios hace el verdadero trabajo, y nosotros simplemente intentamos no estorbarlo
