**Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
The Big Picture**

We hear about the Kingdom of God in many of Jesus' parables. Jesus must have gotten tired of trying to explain it, but he never gives up. In today's passage, he uses parables to describe how the kingdom will spread. What is interesting is that these parables are not so much about our actions as they are about how God builds his kingdom.

Let's start with the second parable: Jesus exaggerates a little, with the mustard seed being the smallest seed and the bush being the largest plant. His point is that the kingdom may look small at first, but it will keep growing. The image of all the birds coming to the branches is taken from Old Testament passages, in Daniel and Ezekiel, about other people coming into Jerusalem to worship the one LORD. Jesus implies that the growing kingdom will attract outsiders to be members. The main point is not to be discouraged when it seems the kingdom is not growing: We might be limiting it to people who think and act just like ourselves. We might see attendance at church in our parish declining. So Jesus is reminding us to think of the bigger picture.

In the first parable about the man who scattered seeds, Jesus says that those seeds produce a harvest, even though the farmer doesn't know how or why those seeds can grow. We too can be doing things that help the Kingdom to grow, without knowing how we are helping. The obvious example is prayer: We may not see the results of our prayer, or not know if God is answering our prayer. But God is making the kingdom grow in his own way and in his own time. Like the farmer, we can help it grow by loving each other, teaching our children about Jesus, caring for the poor and the sick.

If the farmer were to let weeds choke his crop, or be stingy with his seeds, he might not have a very good harvest. We can be stingy with our love, or hurt people with our anger. Then we would be slowing the growth of the kingdom. So let us always be aware of the kingdom, and ask God to move us to do whatever we can to help it grow.

**.Undécimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
El panorama completo**

Escuchamos acerca del Reino de Dios en muchas de las parábolas de Jesús. Jesús debe haberse cansado de intentar explicarlo, pero nunca se rinde. En el pasaje de hoy, utiliza parábolas para describir cómo se extenderá el reino. Lo interesante es que estas parábolas no se tratan tanto de nuestras acciones sino de cómo Dios construye su reino.

Comencemos con la segunda parábola: Jesús exagera un poco, siendo la semilla de mostaza la semilla más pequeña y la zarza la planta más grande. Su punto es que el reino puede parecer pequeño al principio, pero seguirá creciendo. La imagen de todos los pájaros acercándose a las ramas viene de los pasajes del Antiguo Testamento, en Daniel y Ezequiel, sobre otras personas que vienen a Jerusalén para adorar al único Señor. Jesús da a entender que el reino creciente atraerá a personas de fuera para que sean miembros. El punto principal es no desanimarnos cuando parezca que el reino no está creciendo: podríamos estar limitándolo a personas que piensan y actúan igual que nosotros. Es posible que veamos a menos gente asistir a la iglesia en nuestra parroquia. Jesús nos recuerda que pensemos en un panorama más amplio.

En la primera parábola sobre el hombre que esparció semillas, Jesús dice que esas semillas producen una cosecha, aunque el agricultor no sabe cómo ni por qué esas semillas pueden crecer. Nosotros también podemos estar haciendo cosas para ayudar a que el Reino crezca, sin saber cómo estamos ayudando. El ejemplo obvio es la oración: es posible que no veamos los resultados de nuestra oración o que no sepamos si Dios está respondiendo nuestra oración. Pero Dios está haciendo crecer el reino a su manera y en su propio momento. Como granjero, podemos ayudarlo a crecer amándonos unos a otros, enseñando a nuestros hijos acerca de Jesús, y cuidando a los pobres y enfermos.

Si el agricultor dejara que las malas hierbas ahogaran su cosecha o fuera tacaño con sus semillas, es posible que no obtuviera una cosecha tan buena. Podemos ser tacaños con nuestro amor o herir a la gente con nuestra ira. Entonces estaríamos frenando el crecimiento del reino. Así que estemos siempre conscientes del reino y pidamos a Dios que nos impulse a hacer todo lo que podamos para ayudarlo a crecer.
